The first is for the individual who is struggling to engage and the second is for managers/staff supporting these individuals.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. We have a 6-module eLearning mental health course which can be delivered directly to the client in their own home and supports self-management, using lived experiences of their conditions. This course can be used when it has proved difficult to get engagement with the client. There is no pressure on this course, and no qualification, other than a certificate of completion. 2. We have an online 5 module course which can be delivered to managers and staff to help them support their own clients. This is delivered online by zoom to between 6 – 12 people at a time. You can choose either the 3 hour session or the 2 x 3 hour sessions.
